Updates and Issues for Discussion

Gray Wolf Management in California-Stakeholder Group

Last year TWS –WS was invited to participate in a stakeholder group organized by DFW and share views on wolf conservation and management as reflected in TWS' fact sheet and position statement. The purpose of the meetings is to initiate an organized Stakeholder Working Group that will work towards the goal of developing the overall framework for a California Wolf Plan. I attended a follow up session on Feb 5, 2013 in Sacramento, but was not able to attend a meeting in Redding on March 28 due to work conflicts. Next meeting has not been scheduled, but will likely be in May or June in either Sacramento or Redding area. DFW asks that only up to two representatives from each organization attend because of space limitations. DFW expects an initial draft plan in September 2013 and wants stakeholder review and comment within 45 days. *Does Western Section want me to continue to be involved? Is there someone else who wants to attend the meetings as a backup person? Does TWS-WS want a form a subgroup to help review and provide input?*

Harassment Prevention and Member Data Protection Policies

After talking with our insurance agent and the Executive Committee, I developed draft
policies to improve our operating practices. After a question arose at the last board
meeting about how we use our email distribution list, I realized that we needed to make
official our informal policy of protecting our members' email addresses and other
personal data. The Harassment Prevention Policy arose after I received an anonymous
letter about conduct of a board member at the annual meeting. There was not a claim
of harassment, but as our organization has grown, we realized it would also be prudent
to formalize our policy of creating a welcoming and inclusive organization and provide
training for our board members. The training is offered as a benefit of our insurance

policy. It can be completed online within 60 days of joining the board and is good for two years. Thank you to everyone who reviewed and approved the new policies and who have completed their training or provided documentation that they have taken the training at their workplace. Below is a list of the status of the harassment prevention training for board members. Out of the 25 voting board members, chairs, and subconsultants, only 8 have completed the course or provided evidence that they have done an equivalent course. *Are there questions about the policies or the training course?*
