CERTIFICATION WORKSHOP

Where: Downtown San Diego. Fleet Industrial Supply Center (FISC); Bldg. 1, 3rd floor; Community Management Training Room (see note and map on reverse). Intersection of North Harbor Drive and West Broadway.

What and Why: Professional Certification is strongly recommended by The Wildlife Society, as an indication of an individual's university and continuing education, and their professional experience. There are two levels, Certified Wildlife Biologist (generally at least a BS degree and five years actual experience as a professional biologist) and Associate Wildlife Biologist (degree, but less experience). Current students are welcome, it's a great asset to understand the certification requirements while still in school – you can plan future coursework that will fulfill certification requirements. Certification is looked upon favorably by employers, regulatory agencies and outsiders to our profession. This workshop will provide you with the tools and knowledge needed to start the process – no guarantee of certification can be provided.


What to bring: Updated resume, detailed job descriptions, transcripts (unofficial is fine for the workshop, but official copies are needed for the actual application), course descriptions (a college catalog is helpful, or download them from your University's website), a list of recent professional development events (conferences, workshops, symposia) attended. Laptop computers (on batteries) are optional, and most materials can be provided on a CD with advance coordination.


